We promote action which empowers young people.

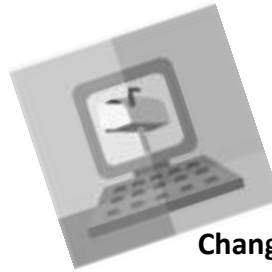
With Devotion . . .

## Paying Hot Lunch and Van Fees Through Renweb

RenWeb is providing convenient, accurate functionality to our Hot Lunch and Transportation programs. Please take time to familiarize yourself with the new process and use it to pay for lunch and van transportation.

To begin:

- ❖ From the Roncalli High School website ([www.roncallijets.net](http://www.roncallijets.net)): click the “RenWeb” button, follow the instructions for creating an account, if you haven’t yet, and log in.
- ❖ *All you need is an email address in our system to create a parental account. Contact the school if RenWeb does not recognize the email address you provide.*
- ❖ By clicking the “Family Information” button on the left, you will be able to see your family billing information. At this time, only Hot Lunch and Van Fees are being billed and paid through this feature.
- ❖ When you click “Pay Now,” you will be able to pay into your student’s hot lunch or transportation account using either eCheck (any checking account) or credit/debit card information. (If using a debit card, choose the credit card option.) We will also accept cash or check payments in the business office.
- ❖ You may pay for the entire year (\$443.70) or just a few meals. The money remains in your family account until it is used.
- ❖ Each time a student eats hot lunch, \$2.55 will be billed to your family account. There is one RenWeb account for each family, so families with more than one student eating hot lunch need to make sure they maintain a balance sufficient for all their children.
- ❖ Van fees will be charged the beginning of each month. Your \$100 deposit covered van transportation for September 2011.

*We ask that you maintain a credit balance in your family’s account at all times.*

We are still learning about our new system, just as you are, but our ultimate goal, as always, is to provide a safe, both physically and spiritually, nurturing environment so that our students can learn and grow.
